Let's tidy up our desks, our drawers and our cupboards! – at home

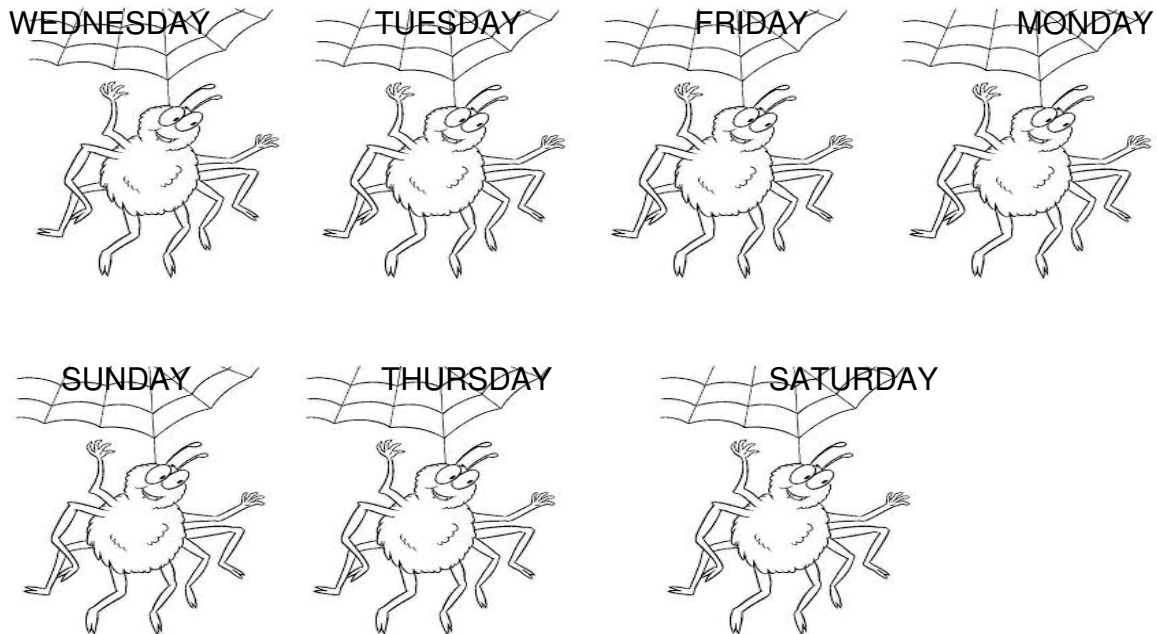
2. "Sisi wants to know better its school activities timetable!"

Let's make together, with the help of the symbol flashcards, our timetable for Monday. Let's decide together on the suitable flashcards.

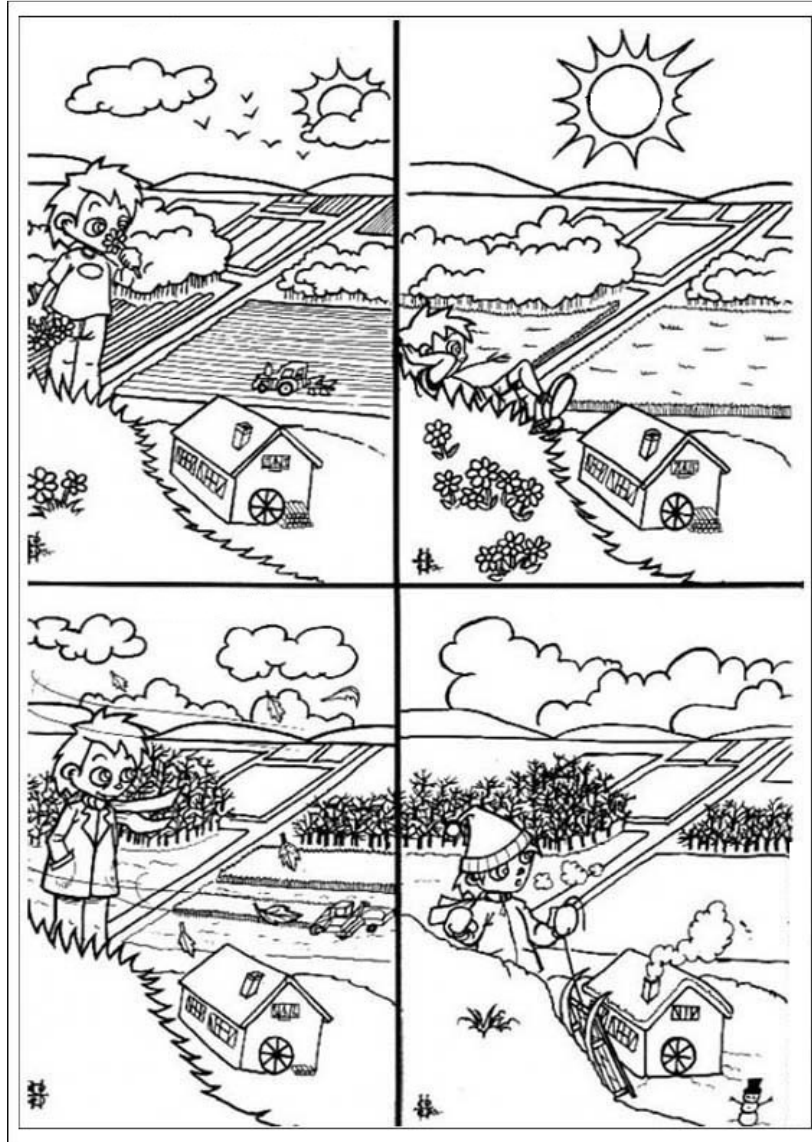

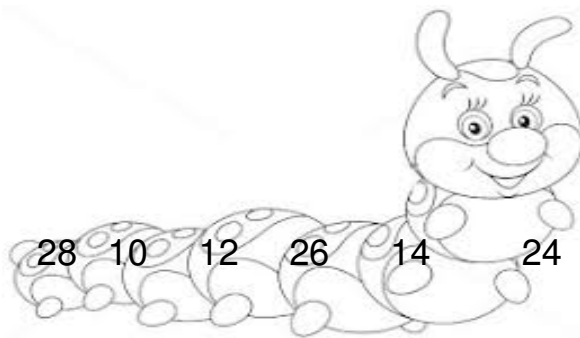

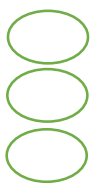
